
Education in Virtue - a way of life - not just a program!

Schedule for 2025-26 School Year HOUSE VIRTUES - All are Theological or Cardinal Virtues

Fatima - Hope - Unity among Christians, world peace, protection, and hope

Genazzano - Prudence - (Our Lady of Good Counsel)

Guadalupe - Temperance - Meekness, humility, protection of the unborn, those unprotected

Kibeho - Fortitude - Connection to Our Lady of Sorrows, courage in the face of difficulties/sorrow

LaSalette - Justice - Falls under the theological virtue of charity - perfects will and relationships. Warnings about right relationships, sinful priests, and decline in Christianity.

Lourdes - Faith - Healings of all sorts. Faith in God's ability to heal.
